1 Corinthians 1:10 - I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you with one another so that there may be among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.
1 Corinthians 3:1-3 - 1 Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but asmere infants in Christ. 2 I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were for it. Indeed, you are still not ready. 3 You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere men?
1 Corinthians 11:18-19 In the first place, I hear that when you come together as a church, there are among you, and to some extent I believe it. 19 No doubt there have to be among you to show which of you have God's
Matthew 6:24 No one can two masters. Either he will the one and the other, or he will be to the one and the other. You cannot serve God and Money.

Summary Romans 7:7-25

- Without God's law we don't know what sin is.
- Because of God's law we know of our sin
- We sin so we know that we cannot earn salvation
- Because we cannot earn it we are dependent on God's grace
- By learning God's expectations of us we realize more and more each day how dependent we are
- This knowledge of our dependence grows into a deeper and more abiding love and we sin less
